Are you a confident public speaker with a commitment to tolerance and diversity? **Why not sign up to our speakers' bank** and help spread the anti-racism message.

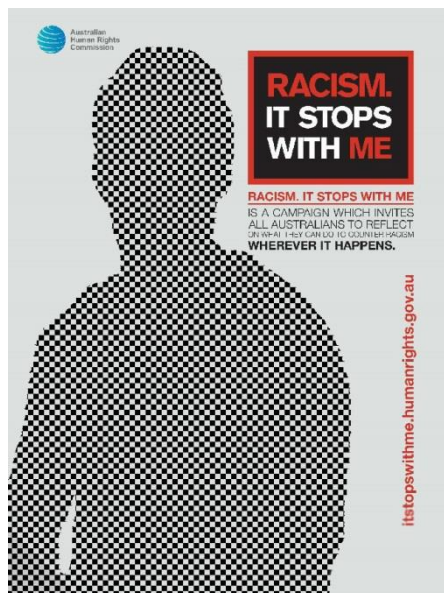
